In addition to language classes, students will participate in numerous activities to discover the city and share these moments with fellow program participants. You will also have the opportunity to practice your English skills in real-life situations.

Transportation

Students are welcomed at the airport by staff and transported by bus to the campus. Round-trip **airport transfers are included** in the program fees for students arriving and departing on Sundays between 8:00 AM and 8:00 PM.

For local transportation, **students receive a public transportation card** with \$50 credit. During organized activities, supervising staff are always present with the students.
