

Summer camp in Turkey



In Turkey, the summer camp program aims to offer a unique discovery experience for young people. The campus is located in Bursa, where international supervisors and certified, accredited teachers teach English. The program is designed to improve teenagers' English skills and encourage its use in daily life while exploring the beautiful sights of Turkey.

English lessons

Students will participate in **16 hours of English classes per week**, in addition to practicing in daily life. A perfect balance between learning and discovering Turkey and its culture.

Cultural activities

To ensure the most enriching experience possible, teenagers will take part in a variety of recreational, cultural, and sports activities. These activities are designed to explore the local culture, practice English outside the classroom, and have fun.

Students will be supervised by group leaders experienced in managing and coordinating groups.

Wednesday:

- Morning: English classes
- Afternoon: Tree-climbing adventure activity

Thursday:

- Morning: English classes
- Afternoon: Coastal exploration

Friday:

- Morning: English classes
- Afternoon: Recreational or cultural activity

Saturday:

- Full day: Visit to the city of Istanbul

Bursa city

Bursa came under Roman, then Byzantine rule before it became the first capital of the Ottoman Empire. A very old and historical city with many places to discover. The city was awarded Unesco World Heritage status in 2014. Bursa offers a rich cultural experience with its historical sites, natural landscapes, and culinary delights, making it a vibrant destination in Turkey.

Your accommodation

Young participants will stay in **student residences**, in single or double rooms. The residence **staff is available 24/7** to ensure the **comfort** and **safety** of the participants. Rooms are cleaned once a week.

Shared common areas, fully furnished and equipped, will allow participants to relax and enjoy leisure activities during their free time.

The campus is located in a perfectly secure area of the city. During excursions, supervising staff will always accompany the teenagers.

Meals

Three meals a day are served in the residence cafeteria, where you will enjoy delicious Turkish cuisine. Meals are prepared by certified professionals. **Please inform us in advance if you have specific dietary requirements**.

Supervision

Students are not allowed to go out at night without supervision. On weekdays, the curfew is set at 11:00 PM.

Multilingual supervisory staff will be present at the residence 24/7, ensuring ideal supervision for teenagers. Alcohol and drug consumption is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate expulsion without refund.

Transportation

Airport transfers are included, with reception at the following airports:

- Istanbul
- Sabiha Gökçen

Local transportation: Private transportation is provided for all excursions. For cultural or social activities, private or public transportation will be used, and the costs are covered by the program.

All excursions are accompanied by supervising staff, who are also trained as guides.

Duration: 1-2 weeks
