

# Youth Summer camp in Malaga



Our partner offers young students a premium summer program in Spanish immersion under the sun of Malaga, a beautiful Mediterranean city located in the Andalusian region of southern Spain. Medium-sized, it surprises with its rich culture and history, stunning beaches, the kindness of its locals, and its relaxed and friendly atmosphere. An ideal destination for teenagers!

Students can choose between 1, 2, or 4 weeks and will be accommodated with full board in a fantastic student residence with a swimming pool.

## **Conditions**:

Only students staying with a parent or guardian can enroll in the day camp. Transportation to and from the camp is not included.

## Spanish lessons

A personalized, motivating, and student-centered educational program designed to immerse them in a dynamic learning experience. Throughout the program, we maintain a playful approach, ensuring engaging and lively lessons. Our native-speaking teachers bring extensive experience to create a pleasant and effective learning environment.

The courses focus on developing the four essential language skills: speaking, reading, writing, and listening comprehension.

- 20 lessons per week, conducted entirely in Spanish, with a maximum of 15 students per class.
- Learning materials included.
- Maximum of 12 students per class.
- Classes take place within the residence.

# **Cultural activities**

A mix of cultural, social, and sports activities is organized every school day, along with evening activities and weekend excursions. These activities are designed to help students explore the local culture, practice their Spanish outside the classroom, and have a great time.

Some activities will be organized together with local youth.

- **Cultural Activities:** These take place in Málaga on weekday afternoons and last between 2 to 4 hours. Examples include walking tours, flamenco and salsa classes, museum visits, etc. (5 activities per week).
- **Evening Activities:** In the evenings, students will have the opportunity to socialize during organized events such as disco nights, movie nights, and evening tours. (3 activities per week).
- **Excursions:** 1 per weekend Students will go on a full-day excursion or participate in a cultural activity at a site near Málaga. Full-day excursions may include destinations like Nerja/Frigiliana, Marbella and the coast, Río Chillar, or Aqualand. During these outings, the school will provide students with a packed lunch and a snack.

\*\* Note: Students enrolled for only one week will not participate in weekend activities/excursions.





## Accommodation

Our partner offers students an unbeatable student residence option. The residence, called Xior Student Housing, is located in the university district of Teatinos. It features single rooms with private bathrooms, a swimming pool, and modern communal spaces.

## Included residence amenities:

- Double rooms (shared between students of the same gender) with a private bathroom and kitchenette
- Buffet breakfast and two-course meals for lunch and dinner
- Access to common areas, including a swimming pool, lounge, game room, and terrace





# Additionals informations

#### • Travel insurance

Every student has travel insurance included in their program.

#### • Security and supervision

Students will be supervised by staff and activity leaders who have professional experience working with young students and coordinating groups. All team members have undergone background checks.

- Student-to-staff ratio: 1 staff member per 15 students during program activities.
- Attendance in classes and activities is mandatory.
- 24/7 emergency phone line available.
- Students are not allowed to go out at night unsupervised. Weekday curfew is 11:00 PM.

The residence will have 24/7 on-site security personnel. Program staff will also be accommodated in the same residence as students for the entire duration of the program.

Alcohol and drug consumption are strictly prohibited. Any violation will result in immediate expulsion from the program without refund.

Any additional costs incurred due to expulsion (such as transfers, new flights, unaccompanied minor services, etc.) must be covered by the participant.

## • Transportation

**Airport Transfers -** Our partner will provide a designated time window for flight arrivals so students can benefit from the group transfer service.

Students arriving outside of this window will need to cover the cost of an individual transfer All flight details must be provided at least 15 days before arrival.

**Local Transportation -** Students will travel via private or public transportation, with all costs included in the program fee.
