

# Summer camp in Argentina

*Impactful Expedition- Argentina*

Duration: 14 days

Max group size: 6-10 pax

## **Day-to-day description**

### **Day 1. ARRIVAL IN BUENOS AIRES**

You will arrive in Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina. Your tour leader will pick you up from the airport by private transfer and bring you to your accommodation in the city center.

Upon arrival, you will check in to your accommodation. We will then immediately activate your local SIM cards, currency exchange, and introduce you to the local team. The rest of the day is set aside for you to relax and settle in before we start the main journey early the next morning.

At night, we will have a welcome session where you will put some group and individual intentions for this journey.

### **Day 2. WALKING TOUR**

We kick off the day with an interactive walk that plunges us into Argentina's story. We'll explore the incredible contrast of Buenos Aires, moving from the foundational history of Plaza de Mayo and the iconic Obelisk to the sleek, futuristic architecture of Puerto Madero.

After lunch, we'll take a local bus to the city's magnificent green spaces. We'll enjoy a scenic afternoon stroll through the famous parks, taking in the beauty of El Rosedal and the extensive Bosques de Palermo, where we will learn how to drink Mate and taste the delicious Churros con Dulce de Leche while learning about the local culture.

### **Day 3. BOAT TO LA BOCA/CAMINITO**

We will wake up early to take a boat from the luxurious Puerto Madero neighborhood and the world-famous Caminito. There we will Marvel at the colorful houses and learn about the area's rich history of immigration. Experience the birthplace of tango with live performances and dance lessons and feel the energy of Boca Juniors at La Bombonera stadium.

We will enjoy a delicious barbecue in one of the typical houses and take some time to buy presents before heading to the hotel on a local bus.

Optional: Entrance to la Boca Stadium (USD20)

### **Day 4: MAKING AN IMPACT**

We start the day with a local bus ride to a school to participate in a Food Sovereignty Reforestation activity. This is a direct mission: planting fruit trees and vegetation alongside the children to create a green, sustainable legacy. The best part will be the interaction and games with the students.

After the meaningful work, we will celebrate with a vibrant lunch at the iconic San Telmo Market. You'll have time to shop for unique souvenirs. We will return to the hotel for our Closing and Reflection Session on the lessons learned in Buenos Aires.

Evening: Heading to Córdoba Pack your gear and get ready for a luxury trip: we will board a Cama (sleeper class) bus for a comfortable overnight journey to Córdoba. You'll wake up ready for the next adventure!





## Day 5. ARRIVAL TO CORDOBA – INTRODUCTION DAY AT THE PROJECT

Touch down in Córdoba, the dynamic heart of Argentina! We'll head straight to Hostel Link to drop our bags, grab a quick refresh, and fuel up with our first Argentine breakfast. Then, we hit the streets for a walking tour of the Historic Center, exploring the stunning UNESCO-listed Jesuit Block and soaking up the contrast between rich Spanish colonial history and Córdoba's famous university vibe.

After grabbing a delicious lunch, we'll take an authentic local bus ride to a vulnerable neighborhood, where we'll spend the afternoon completely immersed in a community project. Get ready for some serious fun: we'll share games, art, laughs, and a meal with the local kids. We'll finish the long, rewarding day with a relaxed dinner back at the hostel, our batteries drained, but our hearts full of the community's incredible energy





## Day 6. GAUCHO DAY AT THE HILLS

After breakfast Escape the city to the majestic Cordoba Sierras. Spend a full day immersed in Argentine ranch life, where a local Gaucho family welcomes you into their home. Enjoy an unforgettable equestrian excursion through the high trails, followed by a truly traditional *asado* (Argentine barbecue) served right at the ranch.



### Day 7. BIOPARK & BOHEMIAN NEIGHBOURHOOD

During the morning you will undertake an insightful field trip to the Córdoba Biopark to study a cutting-edge conservation model. Students will specifically learn about the complex zoo-to-biopark conversion paradigm, focusing on how the institution is shifting its entire operation to prioritize animal welfare standards and create spaces dedicated to environmental well-being.

After our chill picnic lunch at the park, we'll hit Córdoba's coolest spot: the bohemian neighborhood. This is where all the local artists and creatives hang out! Get ready to explore the bustling artisan market, it's the perfect place to grab unique, low-key souvenirs. The mission? Find the best homemade *helado* (ice cream) in the city, soak up the vibrant street art, and just feel the authentic artistic vibe that makes this area Instagram-ready. It's the perfect afternoon for good vibes and great local finds!

### Day 8 SCHOOL IMMERSION AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT

Get ready for a day of genuine connection and giving back! We'll start by hopping on a local bus to reach a school deep in the countryside. Our morning is packed with cultural immersion: we'll participate in the school's daily flag ceremony, followed by interactive sports and dance activities with the students. After lunch, we transition to our environmental project: you'll be getting hands-on to plant native and fruit trees. This tree-planting activity is more than a donation—it's a living memory of your commitment to the school, ensuring a lasting benefit for the community and its environment.

### Day 9 SOCCER DAY

This morning, we dive deep into Argentina's national passion: soccer (or football)! We'll head straight to a local club for exclusive, behind-the-scenes access. You'll tour the official pitch and training facilities, get a glimpse into the team's daily regimen, and might even snag an interview with the players to hear their stories firsthand! The day culminates in a high-energy scrimmage at a sports school, where we'll join local kids from a vulnerable neighborhood to share the universal joy of the game and connect through sport. This is your chance to play where the passion lives!





## Day 10 DANCING WITH THE KIDS

We'll kick off the morning by diving deep into the catchy beats of Cuarteto Dancing! At the Cuarteto Museum, we'll trace the incredible journey of this fun Cordobés beat, learning how it exploded from the city's working-class roots to become the go-to soundtrack for the biggest, most exclusive parties across the entire country. After lunch, we'll put our new knowledge into action! We'll head to a local community project for a genuine cultural exchange, where we'll dance, laugh, and play games with local kids. It's a powerful experience to connect directly with the community while sharing the universal joy of music and a good meal together.

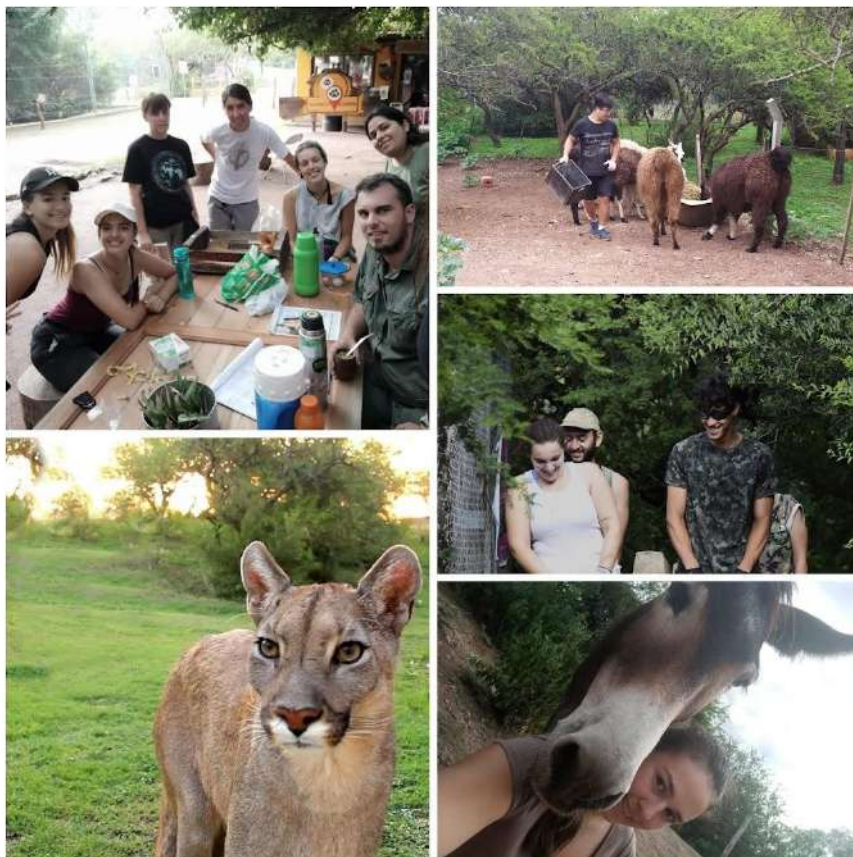


### Day 11 PUMA'S RESERVE VOLUNTEER DAY

We will take an authentic local bus ride directly to a Puma's Rescue Center project located in a beautiful Natural Reserve at the hills of Cordoba.

About the project: The Puma (Cougar) is our **emblem** and plays an epic role as a **keystone species** in our ecosystem. Our main mission is to fight for conservation: we raise awareness and protect regional flora and fauna, knowing that the Puma's presence is fundamental to maintaining the balance of all biodiversity. Our sanctuary serves as the *last resort* for rescued animals, including pumas, who have been victims of traps or the **illegal exotic pet trade**. In addition to the pumas, we are a refuge for other "wildlife heroes," such as the Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle (*Geranoaetus melanoleucus*), Howler Monkeys (*Alouatta Carayá*), llamas, coypus (*Myocastor coypus*), and a cool variety of birds and small mammals. While some are rehabilitated and returned to the wild, others with permanent injuries find a lifelong home here.

The day kicks off with a **deep-dive educational tour** of the Puma Reserve. We'll immediately transition into **hands-on tasks**, organizing the team to assist with vital maintenance work and the daily feeding of some of the rescued animals—a truly unique experience.. At the evening we'll wrap up with a group dinner at the reserve and settle in early to prepare for the morning's hike.





### Day 12 TREKKING DAY

We start early with a visit to a nearby Birds Natural Reserve, followed by a refreshing trekking experience high in the surrounding hills. We'll take a breather to enjoy the authentic Argentine tradition of sharing *mate* by the calm lake. At midday, we'll head back to the project site for a final, delicious group lunch and we will board our bus to return journey to Córdoba city.

### Day 13 TANGO & KARAOKE PARTY

We start the morning by diving into the passion of Argentina: Tango! We'll hit a dynamic workshop where you'll learn the fundamental steps, followed by watching an incredible show featuring the city's top dancers. You get the entire afternoon off-duty for Souvenir Mission Control: grab those last-minute gifts, hit the local shops, and find some time to pack up your bags. Then, get ready for our epic farewell: we're wrapping up the trip with an unforgettable Karaoke Party! It's your chance to unleash your inner rock star, celebrate all the new friendships, and make one last incredible memory together.

### Day 14 END OF THE JOURNEY

We'll share a final, reflective breakfast followed by a short closing session, share key highlights, discuss what we've learned, and consider the impact our adventure had on the community we visited and our souls. A comfortable, private transfer will take the group directly to the airport, carrying all the amazing memories with you.





**Included:**

- ✓ Transportation: Private transfers for all airport arrivals/departures (in/out) and designated activities, including a comfortable overnight sleeper bus (coche cama) journey from Buenos Aires to Córdoba.
- ✓ On-Site Support: Services of a full-time Tour Leader/Guide throughout the trip.
- ✓ Meals: Three meals per day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) as outlined in the itinerary.
- ✓ Logistics: All necessary local public transport required for daily activities.
- ✓ Fees & Donations: All entry tickets to described activities and museums, as well as donations to the community and volunteer programs.

**Exclusions (What is Not Included)**

- ✗ International/Domestic Flights: Airfare to and from Argentina is not included.
- ✗ Travel Insurance: Comprehensive travel insurance (covering medical emergencies, trip cancellation, and baggage loss) is mandatory and must be purchased separately by the traveler.
- ✗ Personal Expenses: Costs of a personal nature, such as laundry, phone calls, optional extra snacks/drinks, or spending money for personal items.
- ✗ Optional Activities: Any activity, tour, or excursion marked as "optional" or "at leisure" in the itinerary.
- ✗ Visa/Passport Fees: Costs associated with obtaining passports or necessary visas for entry into Argentina (if applicable).
- ✗ Gratuities: Tips for the Tour Leader, local guides, bus drivers, or restaurant staff are at the traveler's discretion.
- ✗ Additional Beverages: consumed outside of the standard included meals
