



## Childcare & Teaching project, Chiang Mai



**Capacity:** Up to 30 participants at a time

**Availability:** The project starts every week, all year long.

**Project Start & End Days:** Sundays

**Project Work Days:** Monday to Fridays (weekends are free)

**Support Provided:** Project orientation, training, and equipment.

**Age Requirement:** Must be 18 years or over

**Airport Pick Up:** Chiang Mai International Airport, on every Sundays between 8:00 am. & 16:00 pm.

**Location of Project:** The projects are located in Chiang Mai and the volunteer house is located 20-30 minutes from the schools.

**Meals Provided:** 3 meals / day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) during the week, and 2 meals / day (brunch and dinner) on the weekends.

**Background to this Program:** Contribute to one of the educational projects within the local Thai community and spend time with local children teaching English in schools in and around Chiang Mai.

In the morning, you will participate in English classes in local schools and the afternoon will be spent preparing for the next day's classes. This is an excellent opportunity to share knowledge and grow personally.

You'll be opening up your students' minds and introducing them to a different cultural context.

In addition, you will participate in a cultural exchange by teaching English and helping the local staff with your creative ideas, songs, games, and other educational activities.

## **What our Volunteers do on the Project:**

- You will leave the center between 08:30 and 09:00 depending on the school. The classes you will teach are 3 hours long. Classes will be scheduled in the morning or afternoon depending on the availability of the time slot and the school. You will prepare the next day's lessons at the volunteer house between 1:00 and 3:00 pm. in the afternoon.
- On some days, you will be teaching children in both the morning and afternoon. Lunch is usually served at the school or at the center, depending on the program.
- You'll work alongside other teachers and caregivers in the classroom, where you may also help create lesson plans and organize activities.

## **Conditions:**

This project starts every week. Arrivals on Sundays between 6am and 4pm local time at Chiang Mai International Airport

- Minimum age: 18 years old
- Minimum English level required: Intermediate
- Police record required: upon registration
- Copy of passport required: upon registration

**Recommended Attire:** A conservative dress code needs to be adhered to while at the project. Knees and shoulders must be covered.
