



Technological Summer Camp in Bedford



This summer camp is an exciting new STEM course (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) that combines English language learning with robotics, engineering, coding, and team competition.

This is a unique opportunity for Young Technologists (11-15) to experience working together in the international teams that are typical of the modern science and technology workplace.

English lessons

A variety of engaging and fun exercises are offered to help young learners **improve quickly**. Students then have the opportunity to **practice their English daily**, ensuring comprehensive progress.

In the mornings, young participants attend **English classes** conducted in an engaging environment to build their confidence and encourage interaction. The lessons focus on case studies and solving technological problems.

Teamwork and collaboration are strongly encouraged, providing opportunities to develop their English communication skills.

Afternoons are dedicated to group projects where participants are encouraged to build robots and take part in various technological challenges.

Cultural activities

Moments are organized to build connections with other young participants in the program. Fun, social, sports, or cultural activities may take place depending on the week. A full-day excursion is organized to explore the country and practice English in real-life situations.

Here are the activities teens can enjoy during these two weeks:

- Robot-building challenge
- Fun social moments, games, and relaxation
- Music and movie nights
- Full-day visit to Legoland
- Visit to Bletchley Park

Schedule

The schedules are designed to provide a balance between **English lessons** and **cultural and social activities**.

Sunday: Arrival and departure day. An orientation session is organized to introduce the location, the local team, and to meet the program participants.

Monday to Friday: During the week, participants stay busy improving their English through classes and daily interactions. Group project competitions are often held in the afternoons.

Evenings: Social and bonding activities are planned to help participants build strong connections with others in the program.

Saturday: A full day is dedicated to excursions in the city or cultural activities. Participants also have the option to enjoy their free time as they wish.

Your accommodation

Students are housed in university campuses with single, double, or larger rooms. Each room is equipped with a private bathroom and toilet. The campus also offers common areas for students to meet and socialize.

Laundry is not included, and students should bring their own towels.

It is also possible to stay with a host family.

Meals

All meals are included. 3 meals per day. Continental breakfast and two course lunch options provided including vegetarian and gluten-free

Supervision

Our team members all receive formal safeguarding training, and students are supervised around the clock by friendly, experienced residential chaperones.

Residential team available 24 hours.

Transportation

Transportation is provided for program activities.

If your child is staying with a host family, tickets will be provided along with instructions to reach the campus safely.
