



Kruger experience in South Africa

Head to the world renowned Kruger National Park to spot the Big 5. Embark on game activities including sunset & sunrise game drives & a full day in the Kruger Park, all accompanied by a knowledgeable armed ranger.

Program description

Cape Town offers a diversity of cultures, cuisines, activities and landscapes. With the picturesque backdrop of of Table Mountain, the coastal city of Cape Town lies at the southern tip of South Africa.

From history and culture to adventure and scenery all found within the city, you are sure to experience multiple breathtaking adventures here in the Motherland.

Equipment

- Modest clothing (covers knees and shoulders)
- Bring swimwear for beach activities.
- Comfortable walking shoes, sandals, water shoes
- Sun hat, fleece sweater, windproof rain jacket (depending on weather)
- First-aid kit (medications, sunscreen, insect repellent, rehydration tablets)
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, etc.)
- Day pack, small travel towel, reusable water bottle
- Moneybelt, locks for bags
- Personal entertainment (books, cards, music player)
- A small backpack for day trips.
- Waterproof bags to keep electronics safe.



Schedule

Day 1: Arrival & Sunset Game Drive

- You are collected from the airport (O R Tambo International Airport) between 08h00 - 09h30.

Airport arrivals should ensure flights land early enough to collect their baggage and make their way to the meeting spot on time. We strongly advise staying over in Johannesburg one night before the start of your Kruger Package in case of any unforeseen delays upon your arrival.

- Spend the first night in tents on the Campfire Academy property. This is a beautiful property on Balule Nature Reserve about 10 minutes' drive from Tremisana Lodge.
- Guests will arrive at Tremisana and go on Sunset Drive and Bush BBQ at 17h00.
- Their luggage will be taken to the tents at Campfire. After Bush BBQ the guests will be dropped off and escorted to their tents and shown where the ablutions and tea/coffee station are located.

Each tented unit has bed and bedding, electric light, fan and plugs and has its own deck. There are mosquito nets above the beds or on windows and door openings. The tented units share 3 showers and 3 toilets.

Day 2: Full day in Kruger National Park

- Commence the day as guests and their luggage are gathered around 06h45 for a trip to Tremisana, where a hearty breakfast awaits.
- Post breakfast, venture to Orpen in Kruger, guided by an expert showcasing the diverse fauna and flora of this wildlife paradise
- Immerse yourself in a full day of bird-watching and game-viewing, culminating in a drive to Marc's Camp for dinner and an overnight stay.

***Marc's Camp:** Each tented unit has bed and bedding, electric light, fan and plugs and has its own deck. There are mosquito nets above the beds or on windows and door openings. The tented units share 3 showers and 3 toilets.*

Schedule

Day 3: Sunrise game drive & Blyde River Canyon

- Embark on an early morning game walk accompanied by an armed guard to explore the abundant wildlife around Marc's Treehouse Lodge. Following breakfast, journey to the Three Rondawels of the Blyde River Canyon.
- Around 17h00, conclude your experience as we return you to your Johannesburg hotel/hostel or O.R. Tambo Airport.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Weather in South Africa

South Africa has typical weather for the Southern Hemisphere, with the coldest days of winter in June–August. The climate is mild, with average daytime temperatures around 15 °C (59 °F) in winter and around 20 °C (68 °F) in summer, even though rapid increases in temperature may occur when the wind blows from the desert, which lies to the east and is scorching hot in summer.

Safety in South Africa

Cape Town is a major, modern cosmopolitan South African city. As such, we would advise travellers to exercise the same level of vigilance they would exercise when visiting any major city in the world.

ATMs

It's perfectly possible to travel on plastic since ATMs are widespread. They're mostly located outside banks, though you'll also find them at the airports, larger supermarkets and some shopping malls.
