



Teen Summer Camp in Ecuador

A learning camp in Ecuador, with a combination of wildlife projects and cultural and recreational activities.

Suggested Brief Itinerary :

Day 1: Arrival and private transfer from Quito airport.

Day 2: Treasure hunt in Quito city centre

Day 3: Transfer from Quito to Puyo + Tree planting

Day 4: Project in an animal refuge in the Amazon rainforest

Day 5: Project in a wildlife refuge in the Amazon rainforest

Day 6: Project in a wildlife refuge in the Amazon rainforest

Day 7: Project in a wildlife refuge in the Amazon rainforest Day 8: Project in a wildlife refuge in the Amazon rainforest

Day 9: Transfer from the refuge to the town of Baños + Salsa lessons Day 10: Canopy tour + mountain bike excursion

Day 12: Visit to Lake Quilotoa

Day 13: Bike trip to Cotopaxi + departure for Quito

Day 14: Private transfer to Quito airport for your return flight.

The project :

Founded in 2006, this refuge aims to protect the flora and fauna of the Amazon region through the rescue and rehabilitation of endemic species. The animals at the centre have all been mistreated, neglected or abandoned. Some have been orphaned by hunting and poaching activities, others have been rescued from animal traffickers and still others have been confiscated from families who were keeping them in captivity.

Some animals have been taken in and entrusted to the centre by the government authorities; others have been found in the surrounding area, and some have been brought in by families who have realised that wild animals should not be kept as pets.

Detailed itinerary :

Day 1 (Fri) : Arrival at Quito airport and transfer to accommodation.

Day 2 (Sat): A treasure hunt will be organised during the day. An opportunity to discover the capital of Ecuador: Quito. This city, surrounded by magnificent natural landscapes, is renowned for its impressive Spanish colonial architecture. The city is home to numerous churches, monasteries and historic buildings, including Quito Cathedral and the Basilica del Voto Nacional.

Day 3 (Sun): Transfer from Quito to the animal sanctuary in Puyo, where the group will have lunch. This will be followed by an orientation meeting to outline the activities for the following days. The afternoon will be devoted to tree planting.

Day 4 (Mon): First day of the animal sanctuary project. On the programme: cutting fruit, preparing rations, feeding the animals, maintaining and cleaning the enclosures, additional work (repair work and building new enclosures, enrichment, gardening, improving paths, making signs for visitors, etc.).

Day 5 (Tue): Second day of the animal sanctuary project.

Day 6 (Wed): Third day of animal sanctuary project.

Day 7 (Thu): Fourth day of the project in an animal shelter.

Day 8 (Fri): Fifth and last day of the project in an animal shelter.

Day 9 (Sat): We leave the refuge and head for the town of Baños. In the afternoon, we'll take part in a salsa class. Very popular in Latin America, music and salsa are pillars of Ecuadorian culture.

Day 10 (Sun): In the morning, the group takes part in a very popular outdoor activity in Ecuador: "Canopy Tour". This activity offers the chance to soar through the forest and cross gorges using ropes and harnesses. The activity offers spectacular panoramic views and a thrilling experience. In the afternoon, the group will take a mountain bike excursion to Baños. We'll head off in the direction of the famous "Route of the Waterfalls". The route is mainly downhill, so you can admire the beauty of the landscape and the sites. We finish our excursion at the famous "Pailón del Diablo" waterfall in the Rio Verde.

Day 11 (Mon): We begin this new week with a free day. This day can be an opportunity to visit the city as a group, or to relax by spending time in the park or doing other activities.

Day 12 (Tue): Depart Baños to visit the famous Quilotoa lake. This crater, formed by the collapse of a volcano thousands of years ago, is now renowned for the colour of its water, which varies from emerald green to deep blue depending on the light of day. This colour is due to the high content of dissolved minerals.

Day 13 (Wed): Departure for a tour of Cotopaxi by bicycle. Widely considered to be one of the greatest symbols of Ecuadorian geography, the Cotopaxi volcano is a unique sight and is reputed to be the fifth highest active volcano in the world. We climb up to the Jose Rivas refuge and then cycle down the volcano. This adventure takes us to the park's largest lagoon, Limpiopungo.

Day 14 (Thu): Private transfer to Quito airport to catch a flight home.
