## About the teaching english program

With Bali's rapidly expanding tourism industry, the demand for local English speakers has never been greater. Children may have the opportunity to learn English at school, however, this is usually taught by a local Balinese teacher and thus the children never really get to practice their conversational skills or hear native English speakers.

On this project, you will be spending about one to two hours each morning preparing lessons and around three hours in the afternoon teaching at a local elementary or high school. It is entirely up to you what you decide to teach, however, there is a general syllabus for you to follow and examples of what previous participants have taught for you to continue with.

This project aims to show students that learning English is fun and you are always encouraged to be creative with your methods of teaching – through games, songs, art, sport, and music.
